

ReceptionSpring Homework Challenges

It is crucial that all pupils learn basic skills throughout their school life. As a school, we have prioritised three areas for you to work with your child at home:

Reading	 Levelled reading book to share with your child. (If the book you are given has no words, you must create a story and discuss the pictures with your child.) Use the sound flashcards and words to practice reading skills with your child.
Spelling	 Help your child to spell different words using your sound flashcards. When your child is ready they will receive an additional spelling sheet to complete at home (this does not need to be returned).
Maths	 Practice reading and writing numbers 1-20 at home. Practice counting to 20 and beyond.

Creative Challenge

Our topic is **Jack and the Beanstalk**. Your challenge is:

- A- Can you plant seeds and make them grow? Create a diary with photos/drawings as it grows. Will it grow as tall as the beanstalk?
- B- Castle building. Create a model castle for the grumpy giant.
- C- Naughty Jack! Can you make your own harp just like the one Jack stole?
- D- Create a model of the Giant. How tall is he?

This could be drawing, painting, sculpture, photographs, written projects or a mixture of these.



Creative challenges need to be completed by 10th July. There will be a prizes for good effort. The homework challenges will be available on our school website.
